  AB 380 failed to advance in the State Senate.
- Launched a grassroots campaign to defeat SB 789, a proposed commercial vacancy tax that would have levied \$5 per square foot on commercial and industrial properties vacant for more than 182 days.
- Worked in close collaboration with our Members, allied trade associations and nonprofit partners to secure important clean-up language and technical clarifications on AB 98.
- Led the effort in protecting industrial and commercial development priorities during critical Planning Commission and City Council hearings on zoning code updates in Irvine, Irwindale and Pico Rivera, and on the Housing Incentive Overlay Zone program in Fullerton.
- Completed another successful Young Professionals Group (YPG) class and a highly competitive selection of the 20th class (2025-26)
- NAIOP University programs providing timely, relevant industry education
- Matching 37 young professionals with experienced mentors
- Another Sold Out and successful annual OC BBQ event at the Balboa Bay Club
- A completely sold-out OC Golf Tournament at Coto de Caza Golf Club


